## CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER PNG ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION COMMISSION PUBLIC SERVICE EXECUTIVE LEVEL 4

The PNG Accident Investigation Commission (AIC) is a Statutory Body responsible to the Minister for Civil Aviation, and operates under the *Civil Aviation Act 2000 (as amended)*, *Part XIII*, the *Commission of Inquiry Act 1951*, International Civil Aviation Organization (*ICAO*) Annex 13, and the relevant PNG Public Service Legislation.

The AIC is an independent investigation agency of the PNG Government, and has a clear organisational separation from transport regulators, service providers, and other bodies that may themselves be subject to an AIC investigation. The AIC undertakes no-blame investigations and analysis of safety data. In making its reports and safety recommendations publicly available, the Commission helps to improve safety and maintain public confidence in the safety of air transport in PNG. In some circumstances the outcomes of the AIC investigations can also contribute to global aviation safety.

The Chief Executive Officer's (CEO) principal roles and functions include coordination of the Commission's activities, strategic direction and planning, staff leadership, building and strengthening stakeholder relationships, communications, resource management (staff and financial), and policy advice and research. The CEO reports to the AIC Board. The AIC will be the CEO's sole employer, and if he/she is a pilot will not engage in commercial flying operations.

This position is open to PNG citizens only.
